She was a doctoral student in the University of Michigan, U.S.A. After graduation, she joined the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering in Instituto Superior Técnico. She was a post-doc researcher at the University of Karlsruhe, Germany in 1992. She was an invited professor in the University of Rennes, France in 2004, and cooperates closely with the universities of Grenoble, Lorraine and Bordeaux in France. She teaches courses on Applied Electromagnetics, Antennas, Microwave Circuits and Devices and Optical Fibre Communications.
